Give specific examples from the movie to illustrate your observations.

3. Themes in the Movie

Your essay should have an introduction with a thesis statement, a body in which you explain your main points, and a closing statement. It should be at least 125 words.

Projects

Poster

Highlight several themes from the movie, Under the Same Moon, with your students. Use a Venn Diagram to help identify the outstanding themes. Have students prepare a poster with pictures, words and illustrations that reinforce the main ideas of the movie.

Mobile

Ask students to identify the major characters in the movie, Under the Same Moon. Once you have identified at least 5 characters, have students create a mobile that represents each of the characters, and illustrates their personal qualities. Label the characters in Spanish and English, with pictures and drawings.

Diorama

Have students work with a partner or in small groups to identify their favorite scene in the movie. Have the groups create a diorama from a shoebox, recreating the scene. Students should identify the main theme that this particular scene represents and explain why it was important to their understanding of the movie. A brief presentation to the class can be made in Spanish or English.

MapQuest

Plot the trip that Carlitos made from his hometown in Ciudad Juárez, Mexico, through El Paso, Texas, Tucson, Arizona, and finally to Los Angeles. Research the number of miles he traveled and trace the route he took, mapping out different episodes from the movie. Use illustrations to show what dangers he faced, what he did to survive, and how he earned money to get to his ultimate destination.

Research topics

The movie provides several cultural topics suitable for research. Select from the topics listed below.

1. Immigration laws and policies in the U.S.
2. The Green Card – what it is, how to apply for it, what rights it grants and what qualifications are necessary to be granted one.
3. Border Patrol in the U.S. – What is the job of the U.S. Border patrol? What is their daily routine? What do they look for when allowing people to cross?
4. Los Angeles and the Hispanic population – Research the number of Hispanics in L.A., where they live, what jobs they work, what services are available to them and where their schools are.
5. The murals of Los Angeles – Research the artists of the murals of Los Angeles. Check the Web for Alex Rodriguez, lead artist of the mural, as well as Stash, Asyl'm and Vyal. Research the effect that the murals have had on the population of LA and their importance to the community.
6. Patricia Reggin, director – Research the life and work of Patricia Reggin, director of Under the Same Moon. Try to find an interview with her about her ideas for this movie and why this topic was important to her.
7. Ligiah Villalobos, screenwriter – Research the life and work of Ligiah Villalobos, screenwriter of Under the Same Moon. Research her interest in immigration and the life of Hispanics in the U.S.

4. Videotape the production so it can be played back at a later date for all to enjoy or share with other classes.
